Duties of Churchwardens

In addition to those duties prescribed in the Book of Common Prayer the duties of Churchwardens shall include the following—

- (a) To co-operate with the Parish Priest in the initiation conduct and development of the work of God and His Church within the Parish;
- (b) To be the executive officers of the Vestry and of the Parish Council in respect of matters pertaining to the congregation to which they are appointed;
- (c) To maintain order in the Church and Church grounds;
- (d) To ensure that all things pertaining to the celebration of divine service are provided and to see that everything is fit and proper for the due performance thereof;
- (e) To make available all books, muniments and records for the inspection of the Archdeacon or Bishop and to supply them with any information or explanations when requested to do so;
- (f) To perform such duties as are prescribed by this or any other Ordinance;
- (g) Subject to any direction of the Parish Council or the Vestry as the case may be to receive bank and disburse moneys on behalf of the Parish or congregation as the case may be.

Other duties which fall to churchwardens from use, the Prayer Book or other sources are:

- To make sure that all necessary registers of Baptism, Marriage, Confirmation etc. are provided and properly kept and secured, together with a Vestry Record Book of services. These should be secured in such a way that persons not authorised to do so may not have access to them.
- To make sure that stipend, travelling allowance etc. are paid regularly and in an appropriate fashion.
- To advise the congregation if at any time the funds of the church cannot provide for the proper functioning of the parish.
- To be responsible for the conduct of occasional services such as burials, emergency Baptisms etc. in the absence of the Priest.
- To see that the Church, Hall and Rectory are kept in good order and repair, and to superintend their use.
- To keep an inventory of all furniture, ornaments, plate etc. belonging to the Church and report from time to time upon the state thereof, also to see that nothing be removed from the church without proper consent and nothing be placed in the church without authority.
- To be, in every way, an advisor and confidant of the Parish Priest in the carrying out of his ministry. To support him in public and to be ready to discuss with him and advise him in regard to any problems and complaints.
